## PHASE 1a

Persons at risk of exposure to SARS-CoV-2 through their work in any role in direct health care or long-term care setting.

### Vaccinating NOW

#### Tier 1

- Acute care, psychiatric and correctional facility hospitals.
- Skilled nursing facilities, assisted living facilities, and similar settings for older or medically vulnerable individuals.
- Residents in long-term care settings.
- Paramedics, EMTs and others providing emergency medical services.
- Dialysis centers.

### Vaccinating NOW

#### Tier 2

- Intermediate care facilities for persons who need non-continuous nursing supervision and supportive care.
- Home health care and in-home supportive services.
- Community health workers, including promotoras.
- Public health field staff.
- Primary care clinics, including federally qualified health centers, rural health centers, correctional facility clinics, and urgent care clinics.

### Vaccinating NOW

#### Tier 3

- Specialty clinics (i.e. optometry, cardiology, neurology, outpatient surgery, physical therapy, etc.)
- Laboratory workers.
- Dental and other oral health clinics.
- Pharmacy staff not working in settings at higher tiers.
- Mortuary workers.

\* Proposed strategies may change due to vaccine availability and ACIP, CDPH guidance.

## PHASE 1b

### 1B Tier One:

- Persons aged 65 years and older.
- Frontline essential workers.

### 1B Tier Two:

- Critical infrastructure workers.
- Incarcerated
- Homeless

## PHASE 1c

- Persons aged 50 to 64 years.
- Persons aged 16 to 49 years with high-risk medical condition
- Other essential workers
