She received her medical degree from Cornell University Medical College in 2002 and completed her residency and fellowship in infectious diseases at University of California Los Angeles Medical Center. She has a doctorate in medical virology from Rockefeller University. Dr. Blum was assistant professor of medicine in the Division of Infectious Diseases at UCLA from 2007-14, when she joined Montage Medical Group. She has received research grants from the National Institutes of Health and published research articles on many viral infections, including HIV, HTLV, SARS, and Hepatitis B and C viruses.
