## Medicare Savings Programs (MSPs)

Helps pay for:

### Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) Program

Single: \$1,330      Married: \$1,804

**Helps pay for:** Part A Premium, Part B Premium, deductibles, coinsurance, and copayments.

### Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB) Program

Single: \$1,596      Married: \$2,165

**Helps pay for:** Part B Premium

### Qualifying Individual (QI) Program

Single: \$1,796      Married: \$2,436

**Helps pay for:** Part B Premium

### Qualified Disabled & Working Individual (QDWI) Program

Single: \$5,320      Married: \$7,216

**Helps pay for:** Part A Premium
